<p>Bydd yr Athro Arbenigol yn gweithio dan gyfarwyddyd y Pennaeth a Chydgyssylltydd ADY (CADY) yr ysgol. Mae'r ganolfan hon yn cynnig darpariaeth ar gyfer disgyblion yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 3, 4 a 5 sy'n cael anhawster i ryngweithio'n gymdeithasol ac sydd ag ymddygiad sy'n gysylltiedig â hynny. Bydd mwyafrif y ddisgyblion gydag awtistiaeth ag anawsterau dysgu cymhleth. Bydd mwyafrif y disgyblion yn cael anhawster i addasu i weithdrefnau newydd a disgwyliadau ysgol uwchradd.</p> <p>Mae'r Ganolfan yn cynnig lleoliad gofalgar lle mae plant a phobl ifanc yn treulio cyfnod hirach mewn grŵp bach, heb y pwysau o orfod integreiddio â'r brif ffrwd yn rhy fuan. Mae'r Ganolfan yn cynnig mynediad llawn i'r Cwricwlwm Cenedlaethol sydd yn cael ei wahaniaethu mewn ffordd addas i gwrdd ag anghenion disgyblion unigol. Bydd yr holl ddisgyblion yn cael mynediad i raglenni sydd wedi'u teilwra'n unigol i gwrdd â'u hanghenion. Lle bo angen, bydd y disgyblion yn dilyn rhaglenni gwaith fydd yn canolbwytio ar ddatblygu sgiliau bywyd trwy gwricwlwm amgen, er mwyn hyrwyddo datblygiad y sgiliau sy'n angenrheidiol i wella annibyniaeth. Bydd disgyblion yn cael eu hintegreiddio i addysg brif ffrwd pan fo'n briodol.</p> <p>Bydd gan yr Athro/awes Arbenigol y gallu i addysgu gwersi rhagorol, a'r gallu i greu perthynas ystyrlon ac ysbrydoli disgyblion gydag anawsterau cyfathrebu cymdeithasol, ac ymddygiad sy'n gysylltiedig â hynny. Bydd disgwyl i ddeiliaid y swydd addysgu ar draws amryw o bynciau gwahanol yn Gymraeg a Saesneg, a bydd wedi ymrwymo i hyrwyddo datblygiad sgiliau rhngweithio cymdeithasol a sgiliau annibyniaeth ymhlið disgyblion Ceredigion.</p> <p>Bydd y Ganolfan yn gweithio mewn ffordd hyblyg i gwrdd ag anghenion disgyblion yng Ngheredigion. Disgwylir felly y bydd yr ymgeisydd llwyddiannus yn gweithio yn Gymraeg a Saesneg ar draws y Cyfnodau Allweddol o fewn y Ganolfan, ac o fewn y lleoliad prif ffrwd, a bydd yn gallu cynnig gwasanaeth allgymorth mewn ysgolion prif ffrwd eraill.</p>

Specialist Teacher – Canolfan Y Môr

Post Title:	Specialist Teacher
Location:	Ysgol Gyfun Aberaeron

Responsible to:	The Headteacher at Ysgol Gyfun Aberaeron and under the supervision of the LA

The Specialist Teacher will work under the direction of the Head teacher and ALNCO at the school. Canolfan y Môr caters for pupils in Key Stage 3, 4 and 5 who have difficulties in interacting socially and who have associated behaviours. The majority of the pupils will have autism and complex learning needs. The majority of the pupils will experience difficulties in adjusting to the new routines and expectations of a secondary school.

CyM offers a caring location where children and young people receive a longer period in a small group without the pressure of having to integrate into the mainstream too hurriedly. The Centre offers full access to the National Curriculum which will be suitably differentiated to the individual needs of the pupils. Each pupil has access to individually tailored programmes to meet his/her needs. Where necessary the pupils will follow programmes of work which will focus on the development of life skills to encourage the development of the necessary skills to improve independence. Pupils are integrated into mainstream education when appropriate.

The Specialist Teacher will be able to teach excellent lessons and will have the ability to create meaningful relationships and inspire pupils with social communication difficulties and their associated behaviours. The post holder will be able to teach across a range of subject areas and have a commitment to promoting the development of social interaction and independence skills in the pupils in Ceredigion.

CyM will work flexibly to meet the needs of pupils in Ceredigion. It is therefore expected that the post holder will work in mainstream settings and will be able to offer outreach support at other mainstream schools.
