- support on the strategic development of the Local Authority's counselling and emotional wellbeing service for primary-aged pupils
- lead the design, implementation, and operational rollout of a new county-wide play therapy service for primary schools
- develop comprehensive policies, procedures, and service delivery frameworks for the play therapy provision, ensuring alignment with safeguarding, GDPR, BACP, and Play Therapy UK (PTUK) standards
- monitor service demand and gaps and make recommendations for scaling provision to meet evolving school needs
- promote the counselling and play therapy services to schools, families, and professionals through outreach and engagement
- manage the central referral process for the school counselling and play therapy services
- screen and triage referrals to ensure appropriate allocation based on need and priority
- coordinate with therapists, schools, and families to schedule sessions, manage caseloads, and monitor waiting lists
- track outcomes, assess impact, and ensure services are equitably accessed across the County
- provide expert guidance on mental health and therapeutic interventions in a primary school context
- offer case consultation and informal supervision to practitioners (counsellors, play therapists, and school staff where appropriate)
- provide supervision to primary school counsellors and play therapists, ensuring ethical, safe, and effective practice
- supervise all primary practitioners to ensure they are following safeguarding, GDPR, and BACP ethical framework
- deliver short-term counselling or emotional wellbeing support to primary-aged children facing difficulties
- identify children in need of specialist intervention (e.g., CAMHS) and facilitate appropriate referrals
- collaborate and liaise with different agencies such as Camhs to ensure early intervention and support for primary pupils
- attend safeguarding and multi-agency planning meetings as required
- ensure children receiving counselling or play therapy are safeguarded in line with local policies
- collect and analyse data on referrals, delivery, outcomes, and service effectiveness
- prepare reports and briefings for senior leaders and elected members on service performance and development needs
- contribute to funding bids, policy planning, and service evaluations to ensure sustainability and growth
