- Ensure children's needs are met in a holistic way through delivery of programs across the four services areas of: health visiting, parenting program, Early Language and childcare where appropriate.

Requirement for decisions:

- To support settings in the early identification and support of children with emerging and additional learning needs. Providing advice and guidance to meet the needs of individual children and to plan for the effective transition of children with Additional Learning Needs.
- To assist in identifying training needs and to work with the Advisory Teacher in planning and delivering training, matched to the needs of Flying Start childcare settings, including Welsh Government training modules.
- To attend relevant training and take responsibility for personal development needs.
- To provide direct advice and guidance to all settings providing Flying Start childcare on the delivery of a broad and balanced range of activities and experiences appropriate to the needs of 2–3-year-olds in Flying Start settings.
- To support settings to complete and submit all necessary paperwork

Requirement for knowledge and skills:

- This work will require a degree of specialist knowledge of child development.
- To monitor and evaluate quality of provision and to identify priorities for improvement and to support settings in the development and implementation of Action Plans.
- To work in individual childcare settings to implement action plan priorities and to model good practice.
- To model, advise and support settings to develop their continuous provision, observation, assessment and planning skills and methods.
- Participate in multiagency planning as part of a multi-agency team alongside the family using Signs of Safety & Wellbeing methodology to assist with the delivery of agreed outcomes.
- To monitor the implementation assessment /screening tools.
- To support Flying Start Childcare settings in the planning, observations, and evaluation of relevant developmental activities to meet the needs of 2 -3 yr old children.
- To proactively promote other activities in the areas e.g. Early Language and Parenting
