Duties and Responsibilities

1. To assist in the implementation of the the annual Service Plan for the Public Protection Service.
2. To act as an authorised officer of the Council and exercise any delegated authority in such a manner that the interests of the Council are not compromised.
3. Undertake inspections, investigations and surveys in accordance with the Service area policies, procedures and inspection programmes.
4. To interpret and enforce the relevant statutory provisions relating to the activities being carried out at premises in the County, having regard to case law, appropriate guidance, codes of practice, industry guides, etc.
5. Initiate appropriate enforcement action to secure compliance with the relevant statutory requirements. To include the collection and collation of evidence in accordance with the Police and Criminal Evidence Act for use in Court proceedings and Tribunal hearings etc. Obtain and execute warrants as required under supervision of the Environmental Health Manager.
6. To investigate complex breaches of legislation and to prepare evidence other material for the instigation of legal proceedings, including the service of statutory notices, and to give evidence in court, public enquiries and tribunals as appropriate.
7. Take both technical and legal responsibility for the service of Statutory Notices in respect of Environmental Health and Public Protection legislation.
8. Respond to all complaints and enquiries in a professional manner, bringing matters to a speedy and satisfactory conclusion. Maintain clear, factual and relevant records as appropriate. Ensure that all recording systems generated by the Service are appropriately maintained.
9. To undertake advisory, compliance and enforcement activities in relation to:
 - a) The abatement of statutory nuisances arising from, or associated with domestic and commercial premises.
 - b) Implementing environmental control enforcement of statutory provisions and monitoring measures in relation to water, land and air.
10. Possess, develop and maintain specialist and in-depth knowledge of the major work areas covered by the post; including keeping up to date with current legislation, best practices and Council and Service policies. Provide advice, guidance and expertise at all levels to users of the service.
11. Prepare Service related, Committee, Council and Strategy reports and when appropriate present any such reports.
12. To extract and analyse data from various databases for inclusion in annual statutory returns, performance indicators etc. for internal and external distribution.

15. Prepare, assist and undertake promotional work and training events, including lectures and presentations on subject matter related to the post to both internal staff and external stakeholders.
16. To report without delay any safeguarding concerns to the appropriate safeguarding officer.
17. To carry out such other duties which may be relevant in relation to a post of this nature.

General

The post holder will be expected :
