- Negotiate with individuals, families/ carers, and colleagues to ensure common person-led goals and priorities of occupational therapy intervention based on achieving balance in relation to self-care, productivity and leisure, empowering individuals and carers to make informed decisions about development and progress of the occupational therapy intervention plan.
- Under supervision and within agreed competency and prescriber framework, assess for and recommend aids, equipment, and adaptations.
- Offer or help identify an appropriate source for support for carers where there is an identified need.
- Monitor and review where appropriate occupational therapy intervention plans to ensure that they are meeting the needs of the individual and progressing.
- Apply the methodology of the Signs of Safety practice framework to:
 - undertake timely assessments across families and networks, developing, delivering, monitoring and reviewing interventions as required to meet relevant timescales.
 - deliver person-centered, outcome focused work with individuals, families, carers, groups and communities that promotes independence, wellbeing and social inclusion.
- Assist service users, families and carers to participate in any assessment processes and provide them with appropriate information to enable them to make informed choices about interventions and services available.
